### Sao Bernardo do Campo Landfill - [Integrated Solid Waste Management and Landfill](#)

**Short summary in English:** A 30 year concession contract between SBC Valorização de Resíduos and the Municipality of Sao Bernardo do Campo, Brazil, for a public private partnership to offer an integrated system for solid waste management, including the service of urban street cleaning, implementation of a program to reduce and manage construction and urban waste, implementation and operation of a special unit to recycle, and the upgrade of the old landfill at Alvarega.

**Short summary in Spanish:** *Contrato de 30 años de concesión entre SBC Valorização de Resíduos y el Municipio de Sao Bernardo do Campo, Brazil, mediante el cual se forma una alianza público-privada que ofrece un sistema integrado de manejo de desechos sólidos que incluyen: servicio de limpieza de calles públicas; implementación de un programa de reducción y manejo de desechos urbanos y de construcción; implementación y operación de una unidad especial para el reciclaje, y la renovación de un antiguo relleno en Alvarega.*
