- Establish a common understanding of concepts, methodology, and best practices in PPPs in EMDEs
- Enable PPP practitioners and officials to lead and participate effectively in PPP teams, to plan, prepare, and develop well-structured PPPs

 - Update the Guide


Component 1: PPP Certification Guide



- Encyclopaedic collection of good practices, structured by PPP life cycle stages
 - Written by a group of current PPP practitioners with extensive regional and sectoral knowledge
 - Reviewed by over 80 PPP experts from public, private sector and IFIs
 - Endorsed by MDBs
- Public good: Available for free on program website
- Translations: Chapter 1 available in Spanish, French, Chinese, Russian, Japanese, and Brazilian Portuguese with Serbian forthcoming; Chapter 2-5 available in Chinese.

Component 2: Examination & Certification





How to study and take the exam?



- Self-study for the Foundation exam
 - Candidates can study Chapter 1 of the Guide on Program website
- Free Online training for the Foundation exam
 - Available at the Program website (under "Training")
- Classroom training candidates can attend training courses offered by APMG's accredited training organisations (ATO)
 - These fee-based trainings are available by 22 ATOs and their affiliates in English, Spanish, Chinese, French, Russian, and Brazilian Portuguese

Who has taken the foundation exam?*



- Practitioners of infrastructure and PPPs in the public sector (ministries and PPP units); private sector; and academia
- Over 3,081 exams taken in 3 years of its launch
- Candidates from more than 100 different countries
- Over 80 In-class trainings held during the past year
- 2,176 candidates took free online training
